Heaven: A Place of No Departures

We were reminded last Sunday with our "farewell" fellowship meal honoring Rick, Stephanie, Klark, and Karissa that departures, even when they are for good and godly reasons, contain sadness. The Kenyons had a great impact and influence for good in the six years they were here, and we are saddened to see them go. However, they are moving on to greater service in the Lord that will, by God's grace, strengthen and expand the borders of His kingdom (Matthew 28:19-20; Mark 16:15-16), which is a good thing. There is only one destination, however, where sad departures (of any kind) will cease to exist, and that destination is heaven.

Heaven Has Been Prepared

Heaven, the place, or state, of eternity with God, is a prepared place. Jesus told the apostles, "In My Father's house are many mansions [rooms, ESV]; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also" (John 14:2-3). The preparation to which Jesus referred was what He would do on Calvary. It was on the cross that Jesus shed His blood for all mankind (Hebrews 2:9). It was there He had "broken down the middle wall of separation ... so as to create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace" (Ephesians 2:14-15). It was on Golgotha (John 19:17-18) that His blood, which can cleanse our sins (Revelation 1:5), became the substitute for our curse (Galatians 3:10-13; 2 Corinthians 5:21). Without the blood of Christ, there would be no hope of living with God eternally.

Heaven Comes After This World

The word "heaven" is found in a number of ways in the Bible. The "kingdom of heaven" and "kingdom of God" are used interchangeably (Matthew 19:23-24) and can refer to the church of Christ, which is the final manifestation of God's kingdom this side of eternity (Colossians 1:13; Hebrews 12:18; Revelation 1:9). However, for the focus of this study, the "kingdom of heaven" can also refer to the abode of the righteous following this life. In a clear, last-day-judgment scene, Jesus declared, "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven" (Matthew 7:21-23). Furthermore, when Jesus gave the last-day-judgment scene following the parables of the virgins and the talents, He depicted the King saying to the righteous, "Come, you blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world" (Matthew 25:34). What the church and heaven have in common with "kingdom" is that both consist of those who have

we will exist eternally when our souls enter Hades the moment after death (Luke 16:19-31), heaven (or hell) will be after Jesus comes again to judge every soul (John 5:26-29; Hebrews 9:27-28).

Heaven Is Eternal

While the Hadean realm is only temporary (Revelation 20:11-15), heaven is eternal (Revelation 22:5). When Jesus concluded a depiction of judgment day, He said, "And these [those on the left] will go away into everlasting punishment, but the righteous into eternal life" (Matthew 25:46). The eternalness of heaven is comforting to those who know and have obeyed the gospel, for they shall rest from their labors (Revelation 14:13). It is also comforting to know that heaven will be a destination of relationships. These will not be based on earthly relationships (Matthew 22:28-30 cf. Matthew 12:46-50), but in different bodies with Deity and the faithful children of God (1 Corinthians 15:35-57; 1 John 3:2; Revelation 21:7). Heaven will be completely devoid of wickedness (Revelation 21:8, 27). Heaven's occupants will be there forever! No one in heaven will ever say "Good bye" for any reason, but the bliss of God's and His people's presence will be our joy forever!

My favorite memories with Aunt Ruth were the times she wanted me to help her with her baking. My reward was always my own little cake that was baked in a small repurposed can. Besides cakes, she also would make one of my favorite sweet treats, pine balls. I would help to roll the balls and be the taste tester. Sadly, none of us ever asked Aunt Ruth for the recipe. It died with her in 1996.
