Keeping Motherhood in Perspective

When Joseph and Mary took their baby boy to Jerusalem to "present Him to the Lord," they met a man named Simeon, who had waited all his life for this occasion (Luke 2:21-26). He told Mary, "Behold, this Child is destined for the fall and rising of many in Israel, and for a sign which will be spoken against (yes, a sword will pierce through your own soul also), that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed" (Luke 2:34-35). While motherhood is often joyous, it can also be heart-wrenching, as Simeon confirmed. Mary was told up front that her Son would have a tremendous impact on other people (Luke 2:34a, 35b). However, He would also be the object of opposition (Luke 2:34b), which would bring unimaginable anguish to her (Luke 2:35). We can only imagine the magnitude of hurt that wounded Mary's soul as the blow of each nail rang through her ears. Mary remained faithful and, so far as we know, lived for God under John's care (John 19:26-27). Mary disappears from the God-breathed record after Acts 1:14.

My heart goes out to mothers today whose hearts have been wounded by their children, not by living righteously, like Mary's Son, but by those children's unwise choices, a "foolish son is the grief [heaviness, KJV] of his mother" (Proverbs 10:1). I can only imagine the pain mothers feel whose children were "trained up in the way they should go" (Proverbs 22:6), but have still turned away (Isaiah 1:2). Let us pray for God's comfort and strength to be with these mothers. Let us also pray, while there is still opportunity (Hebrews 9:27), that these children who are astray will come back to God! \\\mathbf{Brian}\)
